# PASTOR'S NOTE -

We are still working through our 40 Days of Prayer and Fasting in our discernment process. The prayer guide that went out last month is a great way to reinforce your daily devotions and prayer for the many different ministries of our church. Each day there is a focus on a particular ministry. I would encourage you to keep the prayer guide and use it beyond these 40 days. Actually, it would be a great spiritual exercise to carry with you throughout the year as we continue to pray for our church, the vital ministries and recurring needs.

The instruction of Jesus in the aospels echoes our human dilemma, "Watch and pray that you enter not into temptation. The Spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak." (Mt 26:41). These words of Jesus were spoken in the famous scene of Jesus praying in the Garden before he was arrested and handed over to be crucified. He desired that his disciples watch and pray. But they did something very human. They fell asleep. Jesus' words are echoed by the letters of the New Testament teaching us to be fervent, constant and persevering in our prayers. So, friends I encourage you to follow the instruction and example of Jesus and the believers in the Early Church when they devoted themselves to prayer. This is a season for us to watch and pray as we come to make important decisions in the life of our church.
