# PASTOR'S NOTE

Recently I was in Orlando visiting with family and we went to Disney Springs. It is a shopping area close to Disney World. Like most places in a resort area, it had lots of specialty shops (M&M's, Star Wars, Lego's, etc.) and plenty of unique restaurants. We were in line waiting to order food at a less formal eatery. While going through the long line, I was somewhat amazed at the production of the people working to take the order, then people working to fill the order then people working to "ring up" the order then people working to complete the order and get it out to us. It was all very orderly, efficient, and the food was excellent. Lots of well-trained people were carrying out their function to achieve maximum service. 
