



Dear Parents, Guardians, and Confirmands:

We are so excited about Confirmation 2024! As you discuss this journey of faith and acceptance of Christ with your children, we want to walk alongside you with as much helpful information as possible. Confirmation is a vast word in context, but Confirmation is a journey of Christian faith in which your child can openly confirm and profess, "This is my faith." On this journey of Confirmation, students explore questions about their faith, which include: Who is Jesus Christ? Who is God? Who is the Holy Spirit? What is salvation? What is the Bible? How do we grow spiritually? What does it mean to be a Methodist? Who am I in Christ and within the church body?

In the Methodist Church, Confirmation is a sacred day of commitment and celebration in the life of the individual and the church. We define 'confirmation' as "the act by which persons who are baptized as infants or young children make their first public statement of their declaration or profession of faith." In simple language, Confirmation is a commitment that your child is publicly confessing to serve God, and the church, through the acknowledgment of their baptism.

As you engage with your children about their faith in Christ, we offer a few pointers to help navigate these conversations at home.

How Do I Talk to My Child About Confirmation?

1. Share your testimony. Share your faith journey of Confirmation with your children. Trust me, they love hearing about the journey of faith mom and dad have taken.
2. Ask your children how they feel about Confirmation and baptism. Confirmation is a public profession of faith and the child's choice to make. It is a God filled choice, so we encourage you to pray with your child about this decision as a family.
3. Utilize the pastoral staff at your church. Your pastors would love to sit with you and your family to discuss Confirmation and baptism. Please reach out to Pastor Bill or Pastor Kitsy as soon as possible. We promise pastors don't bite, but they will pray with you.
4. Consider enrolling in a Parent Confirmand Class to go through the Confirmation process with your child. Spanish Fort UMC has a Parent Confirmand Class that Rev. Bill Price teaches, and registration will be open soon.
5. Educate your family. There are resources to help further explain the journey of Confirmation, and we invite you to take a few minutes to look through them:

Goals for Confirmation

- Teach Confirmands the story of their faith, as contained in the Old and New Testaments and in the history and traditions of Christianity and The United Methodist Church.
- Give Confirmands a basic understanding of Christian theology, including the doctrine of the Trinity, creation, sin, and grace.
- Teach Confirmands the traditions and doctrinal emphases that make United Methodism unique.
- Foster relationships between Confirmands and Christian adults in the congregation who can set an example of how to live as a mature Christian.
- Give Confirmands an understanding of the importance of Christian education as a lifelong endeavor; and help Confirmands develop a habit of participating in Christian education.
- Give Confirmands an understanding of Christian worship as practiced in The United Methodist Church and why worship is an essential part of Christian discipleship.
- Challenge Confirmands to serve God and others through the life and ministry of the congregation.
- Give Confirmands an opportunity to go on retreats, withdrawing from their normal routine and drawing closer to God and their fellow Christians.
- Teach Confirmands about the vows they will have an opportunity to take and the commitments that one makes when one says yes to those vows.

The Confirmation Rehearsal: will be held in the Sanctuary on April 17th at 6:00 PM. *All Confirmands and parents (or a parent) are required to attend.

The Confirmation Service: will be held in the Sanctuary on April 21st at 8:45 AM. All Confirmands and parents should arrive in the Sanctuary no later than 8:10 AM.

The Confirmation Brunch: will follow the Confirmation Service on April 21st. We will need an RSVP with a head count of how many will be attending the luncheon. Confirmation Registration covers the cost of the meal for Confirmands, their mentors, and parents. The cost is \$8 for all other attendees. Please RSVP by April 10th.
