PASTOR'S NOTE -

I write this article with a fresh diagnosis of Covid. Yes the beast is still with us with less mortality. Thanks be to God for the lesser mortality rate! This forces me into a Covid isolation phase which I detest. But sicknesses, though never desired, can be watershed moments. As others have stated, it is when you are laying on your back that you look up and pay closer attention to your Creator.

This beginning month of the New Year has been focused on TIME. In particular, the great theme related to time, WAITING. When waiting is a choice, it is viewed positively as in going fishing or hunting or shopping for long hours. But when waiting is not our choice, as in a traffic jam or hospital waiting room or recovering from an illness, it is viewed negatively. But I wonder sometimes if we misdiagnose time. We have plans and those plans are foiled by weather or illness or other unforeseen events. We grumble about this being "wasted time" or "lost time". Further reflection gives many perspectives about time. Airplane pilots are trying to "make up time". Prisoners are said to be "doing time". Those who are literally dying are "out of time". Some are wishing for "more time" and others are wishing "time would stand still" or wanting "time to fly". Some want to "turn back the hands of time" to relive great memories. Others want time to "march forward" quickly to get over painful memories. And in the complexity of our human condition, each of us can experience these dimensions or aspects of time in different seasons or life events or even in a day.

We are waiting for our grandson to make it out of NICU. We are praying that will be soon. But in greater reality, this waiting is necessary for his greater development as he came 2 months early. Yet as I reflect over his early birth and greater need for waiting, I was reminded how the Apostle Paul used the imagery of childbirth related to waiting for the full redemption of our bodies.

In Romans 8 he indicates that the whole creation is in travail, as in birth pains, until now. There is a great anticipation and joy of our being transformed and fully redeemed. But we are in the midst of time and even prisoners in time held in bondage to the curse over creation and the attendant limitations and sorrows.

But we are not overcome by these struggles, not even our last enemy, death. Paul indicates that we are WAITING IN HOPE for things we do not yet see or have not yet experienced (Romans 8:22-25). We are waiting to see what this New Year unfolds. Some are sick and tired (as in Covid recovery) of waiting. But waiting is often a healing instrument to help our bodies recover and I think a greater reminder of the greater waiting in hope for our full and complete redemption. Just you WAIT and SEE.
